General Guidelines for Students

1. The duration of each examination is **3 hours**, except for **Computer Science**, which will be **2 hours**.
2. The maximum marks for each subject will be **80 marks**, while **Computer Science** will carry **50 marks**.
3. Examination timing is from **10:40 a.m. to 01:40 p.m.**
 - Distribution of Question Papers: **10:30 a.m.**
 - Distribution of Answer Sheets: **10:35 a.m.**
 - Commencement of Exam: **10:40 a.m.**
 - End of Exam: **01:40 p.m.**
4. On examination days, there will be **no regular classes after the exam**. Students will disperse immediately after the examination. **School buses will leave the campus at 1:50 p.m.**
5. All **local students** must report to school by **10:00 a.m.**
Dispersal of local students will be at 1:45 p.m.
6. Any **non-examination day** falling between two exam dates will be treated as a **preparatory holiday**. No classes will be held on such days.
7. Upon arrival, students should directly proceed to their **designated examination rooms** and **maintain discipline at all times**.

8. On **27.09.2025 (Saturday)**, dispersal of both local and bus students will be at **1:10 p.m.**
9. **No half-day leave** will be allowed on the day of the **GK and MSC examinations.**
10. Students are instructed to bring **only their water bottles and school diary** on each day of the examination.
11. The route buses will start at the usual time.

NOTE: *Students must be punctual, carry all necessary stationery, and maintain strict discipline. Attendance is compulsory during the examination period.*
