- 4. On examination days, there will be no regular classes after the exam. Students will disperse immediately after the examination.
  - · School buses will leave the campus at 1:10 p.m.
  - Local students must report by 10:00 a.m. and will disperse at 1:05 p.m.
  - On 16.09.2025 (Tuesday), dispersal for all students (local & bus) will be at 12:40 p.m.
  - On 15.09.2025 (Monday), dispersal will be at 1:45 p.m. as the examination will start and end at a different time due to exams scheduled for higher classes.

- 5. Any non-examination day falling between two exam dates will be treated as a preparatory holiday. No classes will be held on such days.
